Education situation in Indonesia

Many problems on children education in Indonesia exist beyond imagination. Most of them can be attributed mainly to poverty and economic reasons.



In 1997, the beginning of economic crisis had a great impact on every aspect of life in Indonesian. The crisis caused a significant expansion in the gap between those who live in prosperity and those who in poverty. It also made a constant increase in shool drop-out rate. In 1996, children drop out of school in Indonesia were estimated to be about of 6 millions. In 2011 more than 10 millions of children in Indonesia drop out of school due to economic reasons.



On the other hand, those children who go to school, they attend a dual sessions (morning or afternoon) in a dilapidated school. There are also a large number of school children who do not have notebooks and stationeries.
